

COMING SOON: THE FIRST NEW WOODROW WILSON BRIDGE

MISSION POSSIBLE: STAY AWAY DURING 2 WEEKEND TRAFFIC SWITCHES!



THE GOOD: The first new Woodrow Wilson Bridge is only a few weeks from opening.
THE BAD: Very severe traffic impact over two weekends as traffic is switched.
THE DETAILS: Traffic modeling shows...

- If 60% of Drivers Stay Away: Delays of up to 1 Hour & Backups as long as 4 Miles
- Delays and Backups escalate dramatically if Traffic Diversion falls lower than 60%:
 - If 50% of Drivers Stay Away: Delays up to 4 Hours & Backups as Long as 14 Miles

“STAY AWAY” WEEKEND 1

WHEN: Friday, June 9 at 8:00p.m. to as late as Monday, June 12 at 5:00 a.m.
WHAT: The OUTER LOOP OF THE BELTWAY/I-95 NORTH reduced to a single lane for up to four miles. Several ramps on both sides of the river will be closed and detoured.
 * May shift to following weekend in the event of severe weather.

“STAY AWAY” WEEKEND 2

WHEN: Friday, July 14 at 8:00 p.m. to as late as Monday, July 17 at 5:00 a.m.
WHAT: The INNER LOOP OF THE BELTWAY/I-95 SOUTH reduced to a single lane for up to four miles. Several ramps on both sides of the river will be closed and detoured.
 * May shift to following weekend in the event of severe weather.

▪ WEEKEND 2 BACKUPS/DELAYS ARE EXPECTED TO BE MUCH WORSE THAN DURING WEEKEND 1

THE FIRST NEW WILSON BRIDGE

- Safer & More Reliable Travel – Full shoulders will enable quicker removal of disabled vehicles from travel lanes.
- One-Quarter as Many Openings – With 20 feet more clearance over the river, the new bridge will open about 60 times a year versus 260 currently.
